AGES: For our youngest campers, ages 18-24 months

Open your child's eyes to a world of exploration and friends. Pashoshim is an enriching and nurturing program for toddlers who will be 18 months old by the start of the summer. The classroom is a safe and stimulating environment for toddlers to explore and grow. Children will be given loving attention from our caring staff.

Activities will include art, tactile, music and movement, and water play. Our summer program also features opportunities for participation in special events with Camp Katan (our 2-4 year old program), like animal programs, guest entertainers, and all-camp Shabbat celebrations, as well as weekly "mystery" readers.

The summer camp for toddlers is a 9-week session that begins on June 18th and ends on August 16th. Your options are a Full or Half day program, with 3 or 5 days available.

The adult to child ratio in Pashoshim is 1:4.

Pashoshim campers must be 18 months old by June 18th, 2012.

Every day at Camp Katan is an opportunity for laughter, discovery, and friendship.

Camp Katan is a fun, stimulating, and nurturing introduction to a camp experience filled with hands-on, age appropriate activities. Activities include outdoor water play, arts and crafts, music, and games. Special onsite events include astro jumps, dance parties, animal programs, guest entertainers, and all camp Shabbat, as well as weekly "mystery" readers.

Swimming (ages 3-4)

Under strict supervision, three-year-olds will enjoy a kiddy pool experience where they can splash and play to their heart's content. Campers in our four-year-old groups will be swim tested, placed into appropriate age/ability groups and receive 2 "swim lesson" days and 1 "free swim" day a week.

AGES: For campers entering 7th through 10th grades in the fall

Camp Madrichim (\$365 M, \$395 NM)
Develop into a successful leader at Camp Madrichim! Also known as our Leader in Training (LIT) program, Camp Madrichim has been professionally developed for 7th and 8th graders who want to immerse themselves in workshops and clinics that will build on their skills in communication, leadership and ethics, while teaching valuable concepts such as diversity, integrity, responsibility and citizenship. All LITs will have the opportunity to filter into general camp as junior counselors, where they can put into play the skills that they have learned. LITs also get to participate in cool field trips, games and summer activities.



Camp Yoetz (\$250 M, \$300 NM)
Camp Yoetz participants receive a \$200 stipend upon completion of session.
This is our Counselor in Training (CIT) program for 9th and 10th graders. CITs learn to lead both younger children and their own peers, and they receive training and practice in counseling younger campers. The CIT program grows much more than just a camp counselor. The program is a rigorous and challenging adventure that will give your teen the skills to deal effectively with people of all ages, and the chance to practice these skills in a supportive setting generous with both feedback and mentorship—all the ingredients for adolescents to develop the life skills they'll need to succeed at school, in the workplace, and maybe even at home. In each session, CITs will also participate in a special activity reserved just for them. Each CIT receives a \$200 stipend at the completion of each 4-week session.

Note: Fees for Camp Yoetz must be paid in full at the time of registration. Enroll early! Spaces are limited to a maximum of 15 campers per 4-week session.

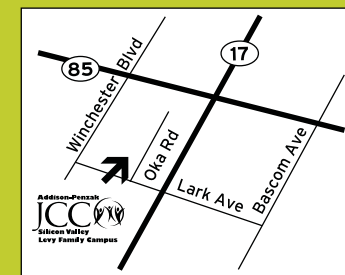

Applicants must be in good financial standing with the APJCC to register for any camp program. All applications can be submitted to the Camp Office or Service Desk. JCC members with a credit card on file also have the option of registering online at www.SiliconValleyJCC.org/camp.

Required deposits per session, per camp:

Camp Pashoshim & Camp Katan	\$200
Camp Yeledim, Sabra, Kadima, Madrichim	\$150
Camp Habima Hess, Tennis, Specialty	\$150

Note: Fees for all camps under \$150 must be paid in full at the time of enrollment.

Deposits are due upon registration. Deposits are nonrefundable and nontransferable to other APJCC programs and services outside of camp. Balances for all camp programs regardless of session must be paid in full by June 4th, 2012 in order to complete enrollment. The APJCC will not guarantee placement if balances are outstanding after that date.

Refunds of camp fees for any session will be granted, less deposit, only if the APJCC is notified in writing of withdrawal prior to June 4th, 2012. Notification of withdrawal after June 4th, 2012 will result in a LOSS OF ALL FEES PAID.

Each camper receives one free camp t- shirt per summer. Please specify shirt size on the registration form, as we order exact amounts.

Children are placed into groups according to their age and grade. Children enrolled in Camp Pashoshim and Camp Katan will have teacher to child ratios lower than California State Licensing requirements. Please see ratios in camp description. Children entering Kindergarten through 6th grade will have adult child ratios of 1:8.

Sibling Discount

If you are enrolling more than one child in camp, the 2nd child, and each child afterwards (3rd, 4th, etc.) will receive a 5% discount for each session in which a sibling is enrolled. Campers need not be enrolled in the same camp to apply. Discount is applicable to the lower camp fee. Discount does not apply to families receiving scholarships. Sibling discounts will be applied on your final payment, due June 4th, 2012.

Financial Aid

The Jewish Federation of Silicon Valley offers a camp scholarship program that provides assistance to families whose circumstances require it. To apply for "camperships," please contact Elisa Gerston at the Jewish Federation: elisa@jvalley.org. Also, please clearly indicate on your APJCC Summer Camp registration form that you are applying for a camp scholarship (check box located in the top section of camp registration form). Just checking the box does not mean you have applied for a scholarship! You also need to contact Elisa Gerston at the Jewish Federation. To reserve your child's spot at camp, turn in the camp registration form found on page 15 and check the box that says "applied for camp scholarship." If Jewish Federation denies your scholarship request the APJCC Summer Camp will refund your deposit. Please note: You must turn in a camp registration form to the JCC Camp Office AND a scholarship application to Jewish Federation.

Registration

Camps are open to all children regardless of race, religious affiliation, or ethnic origin. Membership in the Addison-Penzak Jewish Community Center is not required. Children who are currently enrolled in the APJCC Preschool have priority registration for Camp Pashoshim and Camp Katan until March 16th, 2012. Additional applications will be held until March 19th, 2012 and registered in the order received. All children accepted into the APJCC Summer Camp programs must be able to function within our group sizes and adult-to-child ratios.

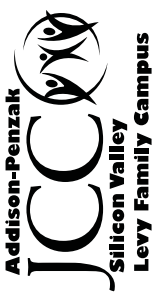
